Kia ora,

We are writing to provide feedback on the trial of the six-hour parking time limits (P360) at the North Beach car park.

From what we have observed, the restrictions have not changed the parking habits of the people who regularly use the car park. The car park remains very popular and is often still full during the day, reflecting the high level of community use of this beach.

In addition, the installation of numerous poles for parking time signage has created unnecessary obstacles within the car park. This has impacted the overall usability and appearance of the area, without delivering any clear benefit.

The trial has also not addressed or reduced the freedom camping issues that occur throughout the year.

From a surf club perspective, our users would find it far more beneficial to see extra parking marked on surrounding streets, and for the unusual "footpath" through the car park to be made safer as a priority. These changes would improve safety and access for all users.

We also have over 200 junior surf members who use this area on a Sunday morning, along with their families. We would strongly support the addition of safe crossing points from the car park to the opposite side of the road to improve safety for tamariki and whānau accessing the beach and club facilities.

Lifeguards will also require longer parking times, as voluntary patrols often run slightly over the current six-hour limit. The existing restriction does not align well with operational realities for volunteer services.

Overall, the changes have not improved access or behaviour in the car park and have instead added avoidable clutter and inconvenience. We encourage the Community Board to carefully consider whether making these restrictions permanent will genuinely benefit the community.

Subject: North Beach Carpark – Ineffective Response to Freedom Camping Impacts

Introduction

The North Beach Residents Association submits this feedback regarding the management of the North Beach carpark and the Council's response to ongoing issues associated with freedom camping. While the issue was initially raised with Christchurch City Council due to the increasing number of freedom campers using the carpark, the actions taken by Council have failed to address the core problems identified by residents and facility users.

Original Concerns Raised by the Community

Residents' concerns were specific and consistent. These included:

- Petitions signed by 900 residents and beach users, to ban freedom camping in the North Beach carpark
- Freedom campers restricting access for legitimate carpark users, including beachgoers, surf club members, and visitors to the North Beach Coffee Shed
- Use of public beach facilities (showers and drinking fountains) for inappropriate purposes such as full-body washing, dishwashing, teeth cleaning, and laundry
- Large campervans occupying multiple parking spaces, often setting up tables, chairs, and washing lines
- The dumping of wastewater directly onto the carpark surface

These behaviours have had a clear negative impact on amenity, hygiene, safety, and accessibility at North Beach.

Council Response – Signage

The Council's response focused primarily on the installation of signage. This approach has not addressed the actual problem and, in some cases, has made matters worse.

Specifically:

- The signage has **not reduced freedom camping activity** in the carpark and has instead enabled freedom campers to stay longer
- The signs are **confusing**, difficult to interpret, and contribute to **visual pollution** in a valued coastal environment
- The placement of signs has made it **harder to manoeuvre into parking spaces**, particularly for surf club users and customers of the North Beach Coffee Shed
- The signage relies on **P360 monitoring**, which cannot be effectively enforced by Council and therefore does not serve its intended purpose
- The signage has caused **significant frustration within the community**
- Local businesses, particularly the Coffee Shed, received numerous complaints following the installation of the signs

Consultation Concerns

Residents did not request signage as a solution. The consultation undertaken by Council was based on a **24/7 restriction framework**, which did not accurately reflect the nature of the issues being experienced. As a result, the consultation

process was misleading and did not meaningfully capture the community's concerns or preferred outcomes.

Use of Public Funds

The signage represents a **poor use of public money**, delivering no measurable improvement while detracting from the functionality and appearance of the area.

Key Issue Not Addressed

The fundamental issue for residents is the **continual and unmanaged influx of freedom campers into the North Beach carpark**. This issue remains unresolved. The community feels that the concerns raised were not listened to or acted upon in a way that reflects local experience and needs.

Requested Outcome

The North Beach Residents Association asks that Christchurch City Council:

1. Acknowledge that the current signage solution has failed to address the problem
2. Review and remove ineffective and obstructive signage
3. Engage in genuine, transparent consultation with residents and local stakeholders
4. Develop a practical and enforceable solution in regards to freedom camping, that prioritises access, safety, hygiene, and amenity for the local community and legitimate users of the North Beach carpark

Conclusion

North Beach is a valued coastal community asset. Its management must be guided by local knowledge, effective enforcement, and solutions that address root causes rather than symptoms. The North Beach Residents Association looks forward to Council working constructively with the community to achieve this.

Having never seen a parking warden down here it was disheartening to see workers who are building New Brighton getting targeted with ticketing when there are no options for them to park. The disabled parking signs directly outside the venue are taken up by people using the venue. Being directly across from the parking I cannot see how these restrictions have made any positive difference at all but there does seem to be rising resentment and frustration at the lack of parking available especially as we approach a season of events being held in New Brighton
