I parked here at midnight - last available so clearly in high demand. As I left at 2.15 am another car pulled into the park immediately. I felt safer walking to this location than to the one or two parks available adjacent to Hagley College at this time of the early morning.

In the last couple of years I have had so many late night hospital calls to meet an elderly parent in ED and was unaware until I saw other cars parked that this option was available. Please keep these - as a female walking on the streets alone I did not feel as uncomfortable as I have previously with longer walks in the dark.
