While we do no usually like bollards, they might be appropriate in this instance before a full redesign can be done of the carpark. They should have reflectors and diamond paint if added. An exit to the road for cyclists would be needed at the Community Centre which may require the removal of one P10 parking space.

2. The alternative is to remove all the P10 parking and add no parking markings.

We note that the coffee car is proposed to be moved which will change the need for short term parking at the North end.

## **North Beach Carpark Consultation Submission**

The core issue for residents has never been the car park itself.

The real issue has been the ever-increasing number of freedom campers occupying the space, which has contributed to:

- reduced access to parking and ultimately the beach for the community.
- Those affected include people that use the North Beach Surf Club, North Beach Coffee Shed, North Wai Board Riders, and the North New Brighton War Memorial & Community Centre.
- Further pressure on parking and reduced access to the beach and associated community facilities is likely in the future given the new William Corporation (WC) development of 50 apartments across the road, with only 26 off-street parks provided.

In response to the ongoing parking issues, approximately 900 concerned residents signed a petition calling for freedom camping to be banned from this car park. This was formally presented to Council on 2 April 2025.

## **Concerns with CCC Process**

As Chair of the North Beach Residents Association (NBRA), I found the process leading to this consultation deeply disappointing.

At the Waitai Coastal-Burwood-Linwood Community Board meeting, myself, Nth Beach Surf Club and Nth Wai Board Riders Club, were clearly told the process going forward. This was later confirmed via our NBRA Community Board representative, Jo Zervos, that staff would come back to key stakeholders (including myself and the Community Board) after considering our feedback. This never happened.

By changing the process without communication, CCC has eroded trust with our community. This process was neither open nor transparent. Why was the agreed process not followed?

## **Consultation Information Concerns**

- **Timeframe:** Only two weeks have been provided for consultation. Why so short?
- Incomplete Information:
  - The proposed site plan included in the consultation is misleading as it does not show the new Surf Club building plans or the carparks to be removed.
  - o It does not show the proposed new North Beach Coffee Shed location.
  - o It includes a green painted cycle lane (replacing the former shared space). This change was never requested by the community, and it creates new safety risks. We have previously warned CCC of this. Plus there are existing options for cyclists to meander through the car park.
  - For decades, this space worked well as a shared area without painted markings. The safest and most practical solution is to return it to that format.

# **Issues with the Proposed Plan**

While we acknowledge that restricting parking may help deter freedom campers and WC residents from overnight parking, if this was to be implemented, key questions remain:

- How will the proposed parking restrictions be monitored?
- What resources will the Council commit to enforcing the proposed restrictions?
- What will the fines be, and how will this be advertised?
- We do not support the proposed 10 minute parking on the street and believe it does not work with the existing facilities in this space and as a beach car park. For example these parks are often used by surf lifesavers to park with trailers for transporting surf skis etc (these vehicle trailers cannot use normal parking spaces).

More importantly, the plan does not address day-time pressures from Surf Club patrols, Community Centre events, or beach users with regard to a day at the beach.

# **Interim Solution (Practical and Achievable)**

As raised at the Community Board meeting, there is no urgency to redesign the carpark. An interim solution would be:

- Ban overnight parking (e.g. 11pm–6am).
- Pause any redesign until:
  - o Stage 1 of the Surf Club build is completed (likely mid-2027).
  - The Coffee Shed has relocated.

At that stage, the community will have a clearer understanding of traffic and parking needs.

# **Christchurch City Council North Beach Carpark Consultation Submission**

The core issue for residents has never been the car park itself.

The real issue has been the ever-increasing number of freedom campers occupying the space, which has:

- Reduced access for the North Beach Surf Club, North Beach Coffee Shed, North Wai Board Riders, and the North New Brighton War Memorial & Community Centre, beach users and community events.
- Created further pressure given the new William Corporation (WC) development of 50 apartments across the road, with only 26 off-street parks provided.

In response, approximately 900 concerned residents signed a petition calling for freedom camping to be banned from this car park. This was formally presented to Council on 2 April 2025.

# **Concerns with CCC Process**

I found the process leading to this consultation deeply disappointing.

At the Waitai Coastal-Burwood-Linwood Community Board meeting, myself, Nth Beach Surf club and Nth Wai Board riders were clearly told the process going forward. This was later confirmed via our NBRA Community Board representative, Jo Zervos, that staff would come back to key stakeholders (including myself, as Chair of the North Beach Residents Assoc and the Community Board) after considering our feedback. This never happened.

By changing the process without communication, CCC has eroded trust with our community. This was neither open nor transparent. Why was the agreed process not followed?

# **Consultation Information Concerns**

- **Timeframe:** Only two weeks was provided for consultation. Why so short?
- Incomplete Information:
  - The consultation photo is unclear and does not show the new Surf Club building plans or the carparks to be removed.
  - o It does not show the new North Beach Coffee Shed location.
  - o It includes a green painted cycle lane (replacing the former shared space). This change was never requested by the community, and it creates new safety risks. We have previously warned CCC of this. Plus there are existing options for cyclists to meander through the carpark.

For decades, this space worked well as a shared area without painted markings. The safest and most practical solution is to return it to that format.

# **Issues with the Proposed Plan**

While we acknowledge that restricting overnight hours may help deter freedom campers and WC residents from overnight parking, if this was to be implemented, key questions remain:

• How will this be monitored and resourced?

- What will the fines be, and how will this be advertised?
- 10 minute parking on the street does not work with the existing facilities in this space and as a beach carpark

More importantly, the plan does not address day-time pressures from Surf Club patrols, Community Centre events, or beach users with regard to, a day at the beach.

# **Interim Solution (Practical and Achievable)**

As raised at the Community Board meeting, there is no urgency to redesign the carpark. An interim solution would be:

- Ban overnight parking (e.g. 11pm–6am).
- Pause any redesign until:
  - o Stage 1 of the Surf Club build is completed (likely mid-2027).
  - o The Coffee Shed has relocated.

At that stage, the community will have a clearer understanding of traffic and parking needs. I would like to see this option looked at, thank you.


As part of these works, I would like to see improvements to the pedestrian walkway that was created last year by removing some car parking. While this area was intended for pedestrian use, it is still often used for parking, and enforcement is lacking. I recommend that this space be clearly marked and "greened out" to visually indicate pedestrian priority, and ideally further enhanced with planting etc.

Strengthening this walkway would not only restore its intended function but also provide safer access for families and young people who use the area. Many children ride bikes, skateboards, and scooters through the car park, and families with prams also need clear, protected routes. A continuous, clearly defined pedestrian/shared path through the car park would reduce conflicts with vehicles and give families confidence to move around safely. Linking this walkway into the current Marine Parade upgrades—including the future shared path—would create a safe, cohesive, and user-friendly connection across the area.

In addition, I strongly recommend reducing the speed limit on the section of Marine Parade adjacent to the car park to 40 km/h. Slower speeds would better reflect the high number of families and children moving through the area and significantly reduce risks.

A zebra crossing from the east side of Marine Parade to the surf club would also provide a safe, visible, and direct route for children and families accessing the surf club and beach. This is a critical improvement given the volume of young users and the busy nature of Marine Parade.

Together, these measures will not only address parking and Freedom Camping concerns but also improve safety, access, and the overall usability of the North Beach area for the whole community.

Additionally, New Brighton needs visitors to help with its revitalisation, and if I was driving from the city for a day at the beach I would choose to go somewhere without parking restrictions so that I could spend the whole day at the beach if I chose to. For comparison, Sumner (Scarborough) Beach is much more restricted in length than New Brighton and yet has no restrictions in place along the Esplanade beachfront car parks. P180 restrictions would unnecessarily place another deterrent on people coming to New Brighton when compared to other beach options around Christchurch.

From first-hand experience, I would say this is more of a half-hour experience. A drop off zone makes sense as it allows people to set up near the patrolled area of the beach. However, as noted in the introduction, Marine Parade is already challenging for pedestrians to cross in the area around the car park. I feel that encouraging higher traffic movement all of the way along one side of the road during peak times will make crossing the road even more hazardous.

I would like to see a pedestrian crossing introduced, maybe just north of the coffee shed/surf club end of the car park. If this was done, it could help to mitigate risk of adding time restrictions to the on-road car parks and the associated increase of car movements in an area with already a lot of peak time pedestrians.

The car park could be made safer and more efficient by changing to a one way system with an entry near the surf club and exit near the community hall with angled or 90 degree car parks on one or both sides depending on what will fit. I think it should be possible to maintain approximately the same number of car parks doing this but it will be easier for car park users to quickly see whether spaces are available and much safer for pedestrians and cyclists to only deal with two one-way entry/exit points to Marine Parade - there are currently nine!

I also think pressure on the car park could be eased by more efficient use of the parking bays along Marine Parade. The off-road bays between Bowhill Road and Lonsdale Street are more suited to (and more popular with) freedom campers, but the bays between Bowhill Road and Beach Road could be more efficiently used by adding marked angled parking bays. Occasionally beach users park like this anyway and don't intrude on the road area, and it would encourage higher density parking on busy days as most people tend to park parallel to the road which uses more space.
