Long Text I work as Technical Services Lead for Venues Otautahi. Whilst this is in no way connected, my years of experience with lighting technology does place some weight in this regard.

I support the installation of LED for this purpose with appropriate focusing and consideration of neighbors.

Modern LED technology allows for a much more controlled light output than previous generations of lighting options. Instead of a flood of light that emits in all directions, Council has the ability to purchase units which are far more focused in the target area with minimal spill.

I would take care to make sure that emitters cannot be directly seen from neighboring properties - this would significantly reduce the risk of complaint.

Finally we are a growing diverse city with differing needs. Whilst it's not my personal thing, sports is an excellent way to boost physical and mental health of our communities.

Again, I am in support of installing sports lighting in this area. I am happy to discuss matters/refer you to appropriate suppliers should this be deemed necessary.
